



How to export saved passwords in the Chrome browser



The guide will assist you with exporting your Chrome browser saved passwords.


1. Open Google Chrome and go to **Settings**.



 Open Autofill and passwords tab and select Google Password Manager.



1. Open **Settings** and select **Download File**.



- 1. Enter your device's password to export the passwords.
- 2. Save the .CSV file to your Documents folder.
- 3. Once in your new Desktop, perform the same steps with the exception of Step 3. In this case you will click on Select File under Import passwords.

^{*}Note - you should use extreme caution when handling this created file, as it is an unencrypted copy of your usernames and passwords for previously visited websites.
