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Vendor Access for Cloud Servers

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The below steps will guide you on how to remotely access the hosted servers.

Step1: Accessing the SuperOps portal

We use an RMM product called SuperOps, which has an integrated remote control tool called Splashtop.

- Upon setup, you should receive a welcome email from SuperOps with details on how to create your account.
- Once your account is active, you can use the URL <https://gtscomputers.superops.ai> to access the SuperOps portal.

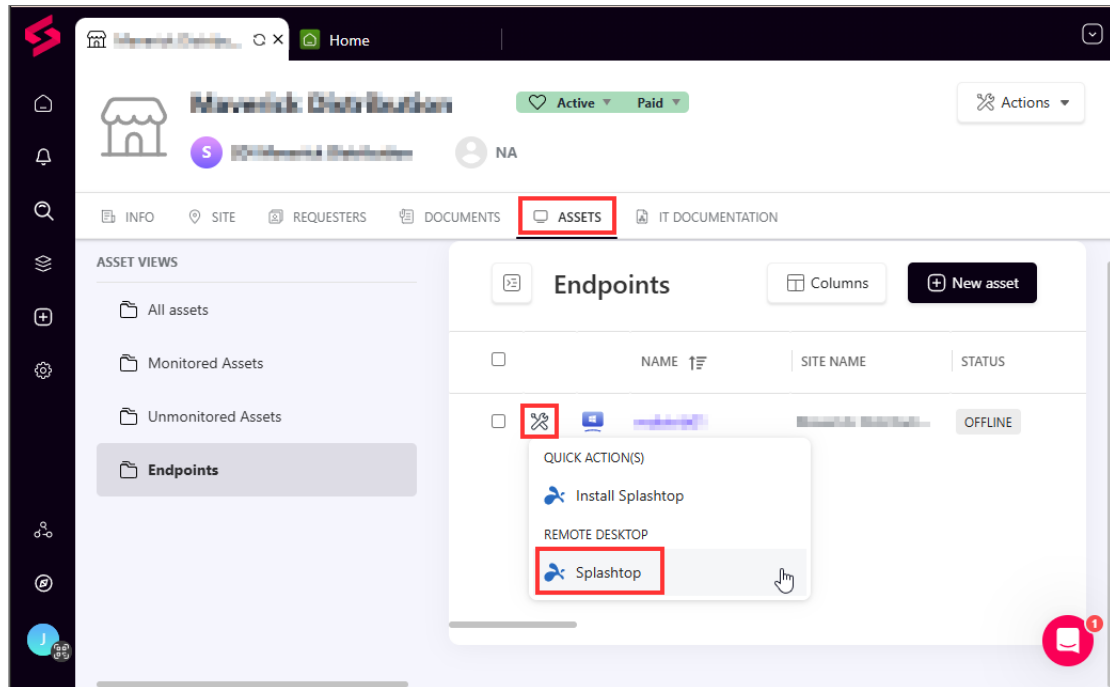
Step2: Installing the Splashtop client on your device

- Before you can use the Splashtop Remote Control tool, a viewer is required to be installed on your device.
- Use the URL <https://my.splashtop.com/rmm/win> to install the needed Windows client for Splashtop.

Step2: Accessing the server resource

- Within the SuperOps console, click on Assets, then the Tools icon next to the Server you want to Remote Control.

- Within the sub menu, select Splashtop to start the Remote Session.



- Once in the Remote Session, you will login to the server with the provided domain account that has administrative privileges'. The username format is user@domain.com.
- When logging into the server, you may need to click "Other User", if another user has locked the screen.
